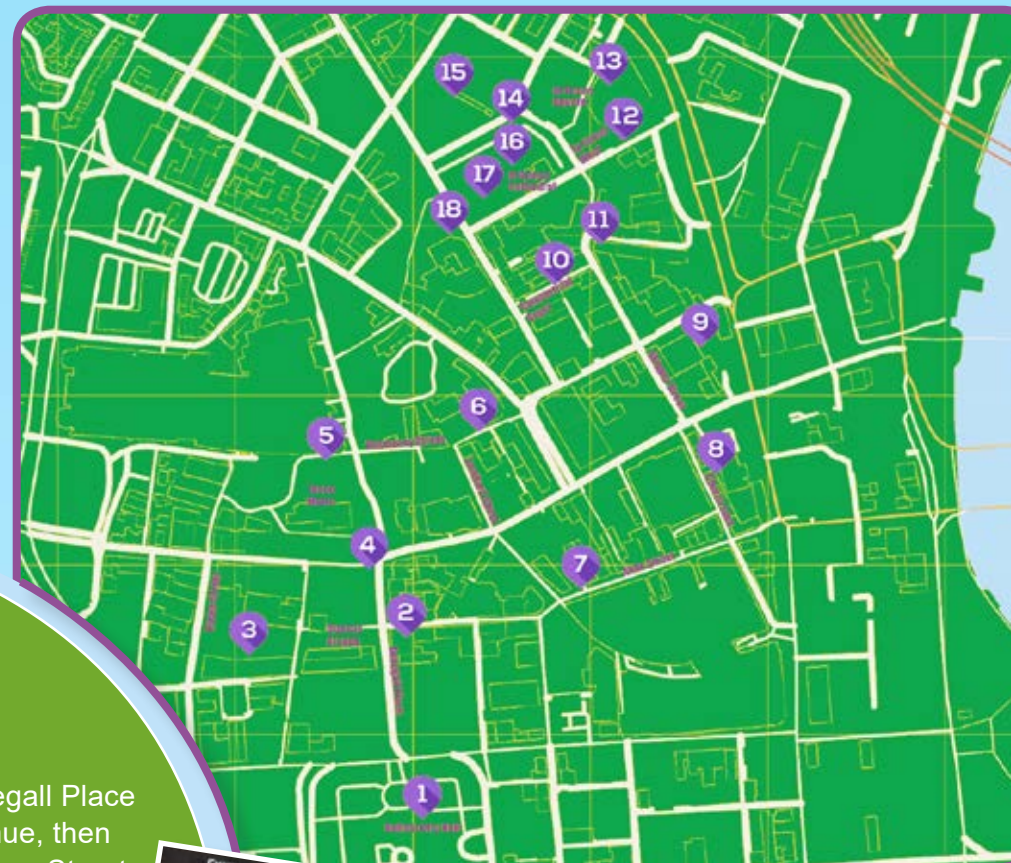
START HERE

Each shaded letter will be used to make up your final answer. Once you have solved all the clues, write the letters into the final answer grid.

Remember that you are responsible for the safety of yourself and others in the group while on the trail.

Don't forget to respect the privacy and property of others. Before you begin, agree on an emergency rendezvous point should someone become separated.
